



Training Course in the Griffiths III Scales of Child Development

The Griffiths Scales have been widely used across the world for many years to assess young children's development. The scales measure a child's development across five developmental areas namely Foundations of Learning, Language and Communication, Eye and Hand Co-ordination, Personal-Social-Emotional Skills and Gross Motor Skills. During an assessment, children are asked to complete a range of age appropriate tasks such as play with bricks and boxes, interactive games, identifying objects and pictures. The materials are designed to be very attractive to small children and the assessment is largely play-based.

This training course is a 2-day practical course for professionals on how to administer and use the scales with children from birth to 6 years of age.

To assist the participants in learning to administer the scales, typically developing children are invited to attend along with a parent for approximately an hour or so on one of the days. The children will be administered some or all of the scales by one of the participants, helped by one of the other participants. The session will be observed by a small number of the other people who are learning to use the scales.

Many children are shy or decide not to engage on the day. This is to be expected so don't worry if your child does not co-operate. This is good learning for the participants too! This is a practice session not a full assessment, however you will be given some feedback on how your child performed on the day. Your child will also receive a small gift in thanks for participating.
